This year on **Saturday, May 31st**, Hot Rods in the Park presents "Back to the Beach" and salutes the 1938, 1939 and 1940 Fords, street rods and Woodies. 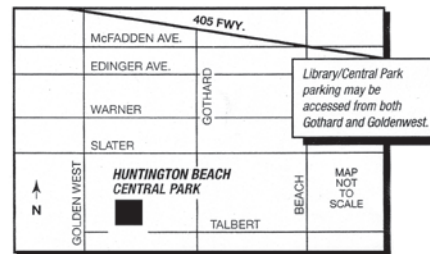
RULES OF ENTRY

1. The Committee reserves the right to accept or deny entry. All entrants will be notified of acceptance or denial.
2. The Committee reserves the right to combine or divide classes depending on the number of entries accepted. If the number of entries received warrants, classes will be further split into "open" and "closed" classifications.
3. The Committee will have the final decision on classification.
4. All cars must be pre-registered by Friday, May 23rd, 2008, and the "Release of Liability" must be signed. No "Entry-Day" entries will be accepted. Payment must accompany registration.
5. All cars must be placed by 8:00 am.
6. All cars must remain in position on the field until 4:00P.M. NO EXCEPTIONS
7. No "For Sale" signs, displays, stanchions, canopies/EZups, detail or support vehicles will be allowed.
8. A club or automobile marque may wish to sponsor its own classes. For example, if the Porsche Club of America Inc. would like a specific class for 356's, we will accommodate them.
9. Entry fees are non-refundable.
10. Except for the Salutory Marque, all cars and motorcycles manufactured within the last five years of the current year's event, will be placed in our "special interest" class on chief judges determination, Based on total entries received by May 23, 2008.

ENTRY CHECK-IN DETAILS - All entries must be checked in by 8:00 A.M.

ALL ENTRIES will enter the Huntington Beach Central Library parking lot at the Library Traffic Signal on Goldenwest (approximately 1/2 mile south of Slater). Follow the entrance road down to the stop sign intersection. Turn right at the stop sign and follow the road as if you were going to exit on Talbert. Follow the signs to the Check-In Station. Transported automobiles, motorcycles and bicycles must be off-loaded and/or parked in the designated "Off-Loading Area".

Your entry fee provides admission for yourself and one other person per entry into the Concours. If for some reason the second person with your entry does not accompany you through Entry Check-In, please have them go to the Will Call desk at the ticket gate.

IMPORTANT:

Volunteers are needed at the Concours to place cars / motorcycles on the field in the morning from 6:00 until 8:00 a.m. Your help would be greatly appreciated. Volunteers will receive coffee and refreshments.
